

REQUIREMENTS FOR BRIGHTER BITES SITES

The following requirements apply to all Brighter Bites sites in all cities.

Produce Distribution—Bagging

- Appropriate INDOOR bagging space with adequate supplies (gym, cafeteria, multipurpose room) and a point of access for a delivery truck and electric pallet jack.
 - o Large trashcans, minimum of two dollies/flatbeds, minimum of 4 large tables
- Distribution space that is the same as bagging space, to reduce the movement of bags and maintain the integrity of produce.
- School's Volunteer Coordinator recruits parent or community volunteers for every produce-bagging day (minimum of 10 volunteers per 100 families served).
- Principals encouraged visit to a minimum of 2 produce bagging periods per semester to contribute to the co-op piece of the model and show their support for the volunteers.

Nutrition Education

Coordinated Approach to Child Health (CATCH)

- All main classroom teachers complete and log CATCH lessons depending on their level of implementation:
 - o 6 lessons per year for Bronze level schools (first year sites only).
 - o Each subsequent year of programming your school will be asked to teach additional lessons.
 - o All lessons logged on track.brighterbites.org.
- P.E. Coaches complete and log 6 P.E. CATCH activities for Bronze level schools (first year sites only)
 - o Each subsequent year of programming your school will be asked to teach additional PE activities.
 - o All P.E. activities logged on track.brighterbites.org.
- School forms CATCH/Coordinated School Health/Wellness Committee to implement additional CATCH components, such as star tasks, and identify and enact school driven wellness initiatives.
- School hangs GO SLOW WHOA posters provided by Brighter Bites
- Principal adheres to Brighter Bites-CATCH Checklist, which outlines how principals may support CATCH in their schools.
 - o Examples: Making the announcements mentioned below and providing positive reinforcement for both teachers and students.
- Principal sends email reminders to teachers about completing and logging CATCH lessons.

Produce Activities

- All main classroom teachers complete weekly produce activities.
- All produce activities logged on <u>track.brighterbites.org</u> each week in each classroom.
- Principals make weekly announcements after bagging is over to remind teachers to complete a produce activity.

Training

- Prior to the start of school, invite Brighter Bites staff to give a 60-minute presentation to all main classroom teachers and PE teachers about their role in the Brighter Bites co-op as outlined above.
- Send school health champion or main point of contact (or other appropriate site representative) to an annual 1-day CATCH training offered in the fall (where applicable)
- Send your CATCH/Coordinated School Health/Wellness Committee to an annual Nutrition Education Workshop. Date and time determined by your city's Brighter Bites team. (2 hours)

<u>Fun Food Experience</u>

- Brighter Bites distribution time aligns with dismissal or occurs immediately following dismissal so that parents and children may participate in the observational learning experience together.
 - o Distributions are not permitted before school dismissal.
- Principal and faculty support Brighter Bites' efforts to encourage parents to bring their children to distribution.
- Principal is encouraged to stop by a minimum of 2 distributions per season to contribute to the co-op model.

Communication

- Principal circulates and supports Brighter Bites Teacher and Staff Participation Policy, which outlines the differences between Main Classroom, P.E. teachers, and other school staff.
- Access to principal and main point of contact via email and periodic meetings, including but not limited to:
 - o Meeting before distributions begin at the beginning of the school year.
 - o At the end of each semester to review school's performance regarding all Brighter Bites pillars.



- Principal follows up with teachers regarding their Nutrition Education requirements throughout the year: CATCH Lessons, P.E. CATCH Activities and Produce Activities.
- Principal makes weekly morning announcements on Brighter Bites day using a script provided by school's program coordinator.
- Allow Brighter Bites to put up external signage on school campus to remind parents of Brighter Bites day.

Promotion

- Print enrollment flyers (up to 2 pages per student) to send home with students at the start of the school year.
- Print spring dates flyers (1 page per student) prior to the start of the spring season.
- Recruit families to sign up in the first two weeks of fall and participate in program for at least 12 out of 16 weeks.
- Encourage faculty and staff to speak with kids and their parents about Brighter Bites and strongly promote enrollment within the first two weeks of fall programming.
- Allow Brighter Bites time to speak with parents to help in recruitment efforts at the beginning of the school year during Open House or Meet the Teacher.
- Show parents the Brighter Bites Parent Participation Video (https://www.brighterbites.org/participate/) through email or text, or at back-to-school events at the beginning of the school year.
- Advertise Brighter Bites on the school website and Facebook page.
- Invite Brighter Bites to school events such as health fairs and CATCH night.
- Allow Brighter Bites to utilize a bulletin board on campus throughout the year.
