# Manager of Data Analytics, Houston (Full-Time)

#### Role

The Brighter Bites Manager of Data Analytics is responsible for leading the data and analytics team at Brighter Bites, and will be responsible for improving our data collection system to be more sustainable and efficient. The Manager of Data Analytics monitors and oversees all activities of data analytics and data personnel. This position assists with the standardization of data collection and management for Brighter Bites program implementation. This will include but is not limited to: testing and documenting data interfaces, drafting protocol for data collection, ensuring data quality by running reports, responding to and resolving data requests from Brighter Bites staff, and assisting in the development and testing of new databases as well as maintenance of existing Microsoft Azure SQL database.

## Position Description

# Manages data and analytics team (35%)

- Align and direct the management, development, and integration of data analytics necessary for supporting the mission, objectives, and goals of Brighter Bites.
- Monitor incoming service channels and ticketing system and delegate assignments to team.
- Manage data staff by recruiting, training, mentoring, communicating job expectations and appraising performance.
- Develop and promote standard operating procedures for data analytics.
- Provide recommendations for database and data-related software planning and budgeting.
- Develop a plan to enhance expediency and depth of data in the field.

#### Database development and data management (65%)

- Provide support for and maintenance of existing Brighter Bites databases and software, as well as providing vision for improvements of the same.
- Work effectively with local and remote employees.
- Evaluate, design, code, optimize, and modify databases and database applications.
- Model databases and develop tables, stored procedures, views, triggers, and other database objects.
- Perform programming and script writing to support data infrastructure and reports.
- Design and deploy data table structures, forms, reports, and queries.
- Identify data entry, retrieval, change, and delete issues, and work to ensure a high level of data availability.
- Work with project managers to ensure that data entry, retrieval, change and delete functions meet business requirements for project completion.
- Diagnose and resolve database access and performance issues.
- Tune databases for optimum performance.
- Perform interface development to access database.
- Oversee database administration.
- Assist outsourced IS team with data access account management and GSuite management.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Education: Master's degree in any field (technology related preferred but not required) OR 5+ years' experience managing data and analytics for a company.
- Minimum 3-year experience in: SQL, managing data collection, data cleaning and data processes for multiple transactional systems.
- Experience with Microsoft Azure SQL and Microsoft Azure Portal preferred.
- Additional Preferred Software Experience: JavaScript / Google Apps Script, HTML / CSS, Microsoft Power Stack (Microsoft Power BI, Microsoft Flow (Power Automate), Microsoft Power Apps).
